Examples of a Haiku Poem and a Name Poem

**Haiku Poem:**

Line 1: has 5 syllables and should introduce the topic (reptile/amphibian)

Line 2: has 7 syllables and gives an impression of the topic

Line 3: has 5 syllables and shows emotional feeling or summarizes.

Title: Salamander

Line 1: Never a lizard

Line 2: Black, spotted, wet, slimy tail

Line 3: my salamander!
